POLICE & RCMP REPORTS

Drivers must report all vandalism to law enforcement. MPI requires a police report number in order for the repair facility to complete the repair.

In the case of motor vehicle collisions and whether they require a police report, visit:

You can file a police report online if:

- You have a valid email address
- The offence is not an emergency
- The offence occurred within the City of Winnipeg
- There are no known suspects
- This does not involve a theft of vehicle, utility trailer or license plate.
- The value of the theft, loss or property damage is less than \$5,000
- · This does not involve a motor vehicle collision
- This does not involve the theft or loss of a firearm
- This does not involve the theft or loss of medication.
- This is not related to any form of personal violence including domestic violence, an assault or a robbery
- This is not related to any kind of vandalism or graffiti that could be described as hate motivated
